
### 2016 Citizen Attitude and Opinion Survey


During calendar year 2016, the Greenbelt Police Department conducted random surveys of victims of crimes and individuals stopped for minor traffic violations. The purpose of the surveys is two-fold; First, citizens were asked to provide a report card on how officers interact with the public on a daily basis. Secondly, it allows citizens who live, work or travel through the City of Greenbelt to voice concerns about the Department or issues in the community. The Citizen Contact Surveys and Traffic Surveys are sent out monthly to provide "fresh" data to ensure the Chief of Police and Command Staff are kept abreast of individual concerns.


The Department randomly surveyed (480) people in 2016, forty (40) each month, who have had contact with the agency either by way of a traffic stop or by contacting the Department to report an incident. The return was 8% (20) for Traffic Surveys and 10% (25) Citizen Contact Surveys. While not scientific, the survey is a legitimate tool to assess how the Department is serving the community.





### Analysis:

The total violation numbers for 2016 are lower than 2015 (5,800 violations compared to 5,866). While these numbers show a 1% decrease in violations, an additional factor must be considered when analyzing the violation numbers. The camera on Rt. 201NB at Cherrywood Lane was out of service from October 7, 2016 through November 23, 2016 as a result of damage from a vehicle crash. If we were to replace the actual number of violations for this time period with the average number for the location, the data shows a 3% increase in 2016 violations.

### Introduction

Authorized by the Maryland General Assembly on October 1, 2009 and codified under Transportation Article 21-809, municipalities were given the authority to utilize automated speed enforcement in school zones. The fundamental objectives underlying the use of automated speed enforcement in school zones are to increase driver awareness of speed related crashes, encourage a change in driver behavior and increase the safety of pedestrians and other motorist in school zones.

Recognizing that speeding vehicles in schools zones presented a significant public safety problem to not only schoolchildren but to all individuals, both pedestrian and vehicular, the City of Greenbelt, Maryland embarked on a process to implement speed cameras in school zones. Numerous speed studies were conducted throughout the City and while speeding vehicles were detected around all schools, several schools had particularly high violation rates.

The Council passed on April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012 Ordnance No. 1320, that added the authority under of the City Code to utilize speed camera systems in the City.

In order to comply with the mandates listed under Transportation Article 21-809 and establish a fully legal and compliant speed camera program, the City Council, via Resolution 1095, established school zones around five schools within the City limits.

These schools and the one-half mile radius school zones established around them are as follow:

- 1) Roosevelt High School
- 2) Greenbelt Middle School
- 3) Greenbelt Elementary School
- 4) Turning Point Academy
- 5) Springhill Lake Elementary School


In addition to gathering speed violation data, conduction public hearings and passing the necessary ordinances and resolutions, the City and the Police Department were also in discussion with potential speed camera vendors who could supply the necessary equipment and back office support to ensure a successful program.

On May  $15^{th}$ , 2012, the City of Greenbelt chose Brekford Corporation as the speed camera vendor for the City of Greenbelt Speed Camera Program.



















### **SPEED PROGRAM COMPARISON AND ANALYSIS**
