5. Oath Of Office - Council Elect

Section 71 of the City Charter provides that every Member of Council shall, before entering upon the duties of his or her office, take and subscribe to a specified oath or affirmation, to be made before the retiring Mayor or Mayor Pro Tem.

6. Election Of Temporary Chairperson

The first item of business for the new Council is to select a temporary chairperson to conduct the meeting until the new Mayor is elected.

7. Election Of Mayor

Section 6 of the City Charter provides that at its first meeting following a regular election, the City Council shall choose one of its members as Mayor and that the Mayor will preside at meetings of Council and exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be provided by the Charter and ordinances of the City. The Charter further states that the Mayor shall be recognized as the head of City government for all ceremonial purposes, by the courts for serving civil purposes, and by the Governor of the state for purposes of military law.

8. Administration Of Oath Of Office To The Mayor

Section 71 of the City Charter provides that the Mayor shall also take the oath of office prescribed in the Charter before the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County, or before a sworn deputy. Sydney J. Harrison, Clerk of the Circuit Court, or his deputy, will be present to administer the oath of office.

10. Election Of Mayor Pro Tem

Section 6 of the City Charter provides that at its first meeting the Council shall also choose one of its members as the Mayor Pro Tem. If a vacancy occurs in the office of

Mayor, or in case of the Mayor's absence or disability, the Mayor Pro Tem shall act as Mayor for the unexpired term or during the continuance of the absence or disability.
