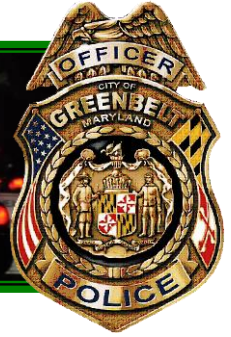

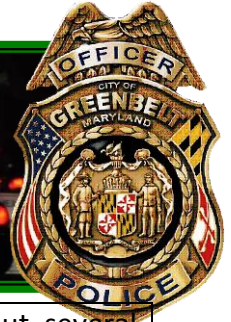
Automotive Crime - City Wide

The suspect found on foot nearby and was positively identified by the victim and arrested. The suspect was transported to the Department of Corrections for a hearing before a District Court Commissioner.
