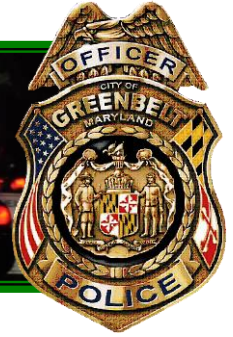
04/13	5700 block Greenbelt Metro Drive. Shooting. Officers responded to a possible shooting in the parking lot area of the Greenbelt Metro Station. A male victim was located suffering from multiple gunshot wounds and was transported to a local hospital, where he was listed in stable condition. The incident is being investigated by the Metro Transit Police Department. On April 15 th an 18 year old District Heights, MD man was arrested in connection to the crime.

04/17	9200 block Springhill Lane. Robbery. The victim, a cashier at the Hunan China Restaurant, advised that he was inside the restaurant when the two suspects entered the restaurant, with one armed with what appeared to be a semiautomatic pistol. The victim was forced to the ground as one of the suspects removed money from the cash register. After obtaining the money both suspect fled the area on foot. The suspects are described as two black males, each 5'8", 160 pounds, wearing all black clothing and black ski masks. A possible third suspect observed standing outside the front door during the robbery is described as a black male, 5'8", 160 pounds, no further.

04/12 1:53 A.M.	7200 block South Ora Court. Attempt burglary. The victim advised that he was laying down in the living room when he observed a subject shining a light on the window. The subject then opened an unsecured window and attempted to enter the home. The victim yelled at the suspect, who then fled the area. The victim believes he knows the indemnity of the suspect and believes he wanted to talk to one of the residents. The suspect is described as a black male, 23 years of age, 5'10", 200 pounds, with black hair in dreadlocks. The investigation is ongoing.
04/13 11:36 A.M.	7200 block Mandan Road. Fraud. The victim advised that she received a phone call that her grandson was involved in a motor vehicle accident out of state while intoxicated and had been arrested. The victim was told that she needed to send money to assist her grandson. After sending money to a bank account as directed she discovered that her grandson had not been involved in any accident. The investigation is ongoing.
04/15 3:56 A.M.	7600 block Greenbelt Road. Strong armed robbery. The two suspects entered the CVS Pharmacy, hopped over the counter and told the employees to get on the floor. The suspects then took prescription medication and cash. Both suspects then fled the area, possibly getting into a vehicle described as a blue in color 4-door. The suspects are described as a black male, 5'7", wearing all black clothing and a mask and an unknown male with a light complexion, 5'8", wearing all black clothing and a mask.
04/17 5:42 P.M.	7900 block Vanity Fair Drive. Theft. The victim advised that on December 5 th , 2017 unknown person(s) removed a parcel package from the front stoop of her residence. Unknown reason for the delay in reporting the theft.

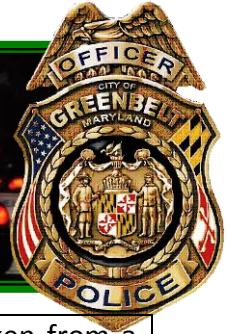
