The Board continued its discussion from its April 11th meeting on a proposed text amendment that would allow for the construction of a 150 unit multi-family condominium development on the former nursing home property. Board members agreed that future approvals must carefully evaluate transportation impacts, as well as architecture, noise attenuation, architecture and security. The Board expressed support for the concept and related text amendment pursuit to the covenant being amended and approved by the City.

Mr. Chernikoff made a motion to support the concept and related texted amendment pursuit to the covenant being amended and agreed to. Mr. Gibbons seconded the motion. The motion passed 4 to 0.
