RESOLUTION NUMBER 1074

A RESOLUTION TO NEGOTIATE THE PURCHASE OF POOL WHITE COAT SERVICES AND TRANSITION LINE INSTALLATION FROM WILCOXON CONSTRUCTION OF ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND, FOR THE GREENBELT AQUATIC AND FITNESS CENTER AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$38,000.

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WHEREAS, the City has been notified by the Prince George's County Health Department that the white coat on the outdoor pool of the Greenbelt Aquatics and Fitness Center needs to be repaired, as well as a transition line installed, prior to the next inspection for annual license from the County before opening on May 28, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Wilcoxon Construction provided the initial white coat of the indoor and outdoor pools, and also was awarded the bid to install the white coat resurfacing of the indoor pool in 2009; and

WHEREAS, Wilcoxon Construction has established a good working relationship with the City by providing both excellent quality work and timely work; and

WHEREAS, Wilcoxon Construction is a leader in the industry for this type of specialized and technical work; and

WHEREAS, Wilcoxon Construction will provide white coat resurfacing for the main pool at a cost of \$36,259 and the transition line installation at a cost of \$1,272; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the Fiscal Year 2011 Capital Projects Fund for this project. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to contract with Wilcoxon Construction of Rockville, Maryland, for the purchase of pool white coat services and transition line installation for the Greenbelt Aquatic and Fitness, at a cost not to exceed \$38,000.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, at its regular meeting of April 11, 2011.
