A RESOLUTION TO NEGOTIATE THE PURCHASE OF A 2007 FORD TRUCK WITH TEREX AERIAL UNIT FROM UTILITY EQUIPMENT LEASING CORPORATION OF WAUKESHA, WISCONSIN AT A COST OF \$34,595

WHEREAS, the City's aerial lift truck is over 23 years old and did not pass its last State required inspection due to its poor mechanical condition; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2012 Replacement Fund included \$35,000 to be used for the replacement of the aerial lift vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Public Works staff conducted an extensive search for used trucks with aerial lifts and determined there are a very limited number of vendors with the closest being Utility Equipment Leasing Corporation of Waukesha, Wisconsin, with a dealership in York, PA; and

WHEREAS, Utility Equipment Leasing Corporation offered a monthly rental option for a 2007 Ford Truck with Terex Aerial Unit to the City with a portion of the monthly rental fee to be applied towards the future purchase of the unit, if that occurred; and

WHEREAS, Public Works has been renting the unit since September 2012 and determined that the unit meets the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, Utility Equipment Leasing Corporation has agreed to offer the unit to the City at a purchase cost of \$39,275, less rental recapture fees of \$4,680; and

WHEREAS, the City of College Park has agreed to pay 20% of the unit cost, or \$7,855, since the aerial unit will be used by them for hanging of banners in their City. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to negotiate the purchase of a 2007 Ford Truck with Terex Aerial Unit from Utility Equipment Leasing Corporation of Waukesha, Wisconsin, at a cost of \$34,595, as offered in their quotation of August 1, 2012.
