RESOLUTION NUMBER 2020

A RESOLUTION TO NEGOTIATE FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF PAVEDRAIN BLOCKS AT THE SPRINGHILL LAKE RECREATION CENTER PARKING LOT AS PART OF A NATIONAL FISH AND WILDLIFE FOUNDATION FUNDED PROJECT ENTITLED “GREENING SPRINGHILL LAKE RECREATION CENTER PARKING LOT” FROM IVY HILL LAND SERVICES, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$143,338.56.

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WHEREAS, the City was awarded grant funds from the National Fish and Wildlife Federation for a project titled, “Greening Springhill Lake Recreation Center parking Lot”; and

WHEREAS, the City stipulated in its grant application that it would use the PaveDrain System, a permeable articulating concrete block; and

WHEREAS, City staff sought price quotes from three authorized installers of PaveDrain System; and

WHEREAS, Ivy Hill Land Services of Upper Marlboro, Maryland submitted the lowest quote for installing 15,000 square feet of PaveDrain System per manufacturer specifications; and

WHEREAS, the City will contract separately with EMCO, the manufacturers of the PaveDrain system, to purchase the PaveDrain System directly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to contract with Ivy Hill Land Services of Upper Marlboro, Maryland for construction services related to the installation of 15,000 square feet of PaveDrain system for the “Greening Springhill Lake Recreation Center Parking Lot” project at a cost of \$143,338.56.
