A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION 1019, A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE CERTAIN GOODS AND SERVICES FROM VARIOUS VENDORS AS ENUMERATED HEREIN WHEN TOTAL FISCAL YEAR PURCHASES FROM EACH VENDOR EXCEED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000)

WHEREAS, the Finance Department is in need of additional staff assistance for a temporary period, since it has been short-staffed since September and will have another employee start maternity leave just as a new hire begins in February; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department needs to contract with a vendor that specializes in temporary employees with specific accounting skills; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department has successfully contracted with Accountemps to assist with the additional work load that occurs when preparing the CAFR, W-2s, and other year end reporting deadlines; and

WHEREAS, all costs proposed for the use of Accountemps will be offset by salary savings. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that Resolution 1019 be amended to include Accountemps of Greenbelt, Maryland.
