RESOLUTION NUMBER 1028

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT, MARYLAND, TO AUTHORIZE ACCEPTANCE OF BOND BILL FUNDS FROM THE MARYLAND LEGISLATURE, TO AUTHORIZE ACCEPTANCE OF THE REQUIREMENT FOR A PRESERVATION EASEMENT ON THE PROPERTY, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS (GREENBELT THEATER)

WHEREAS, the City of Greenbelt has received funding through Chapter 488 of the Laws of Maryland House Bill 51 (the "Bond Bill") and the City Council has deemed it to be in the best interest of the City of Greenbelt to accept the Bond Bill funds (the "Grant") made available by the Board of Public Works ("BPW"), in conjunction with a grant application made to the Maryland Historical Trust (the "Trust"), to finance, in part, the costs for the construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction and capital equipping of the Historic Greenbelt Theater (the "Project"). NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland that the Project is hereby approved, that the City of Greenbelt is authorized to apply for and, if approved, enter into the Grant in accordance with the terms and provisions of the documents evidencing the Grant including a Deed of Easement (collectively, the "Grant Documents") which may be required by BPW or the Trust.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager of the City of Greenbelt is authorized and directed to make or cause to be made and to execute and deliver, on behalf of the City of Greenbelt, such certificates and statements and any and all other papers, instruments, or documents that may be necessary, convenient, or desirable to complete the transaction.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all actions the City of Greenbelt, its duly authorized officers, agents, servants, and employees, for and on behalf of the City of Greenbelt, which have been taken in connection with the Grant, are hereby ratified, confirmed and adopted.
