RESOLUTION NUMBER 1018

A Resolution to Negotiate the Purchase, Installation, and Maintenance Services of a Surveillance Camera System for Roosevelt Center with Avrio Group Surveillance Solutions, Inc., of Easton, Maryland, at a Cost of \$39,518

WHEREAS, for some time, the surveillance camera system at Roosevelt Center has been in need of repair and upgrade; and

WHEREAS, upgrading the existing system to enable motion-control by the Police Department was not practical because of the cost and logistics of building fiber cabling; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that advancements in technology have made replacement of the Roosevelt Center camera surveillance system a better option than repair; and

WHEREAS, the City has looked at a number of different systems and vendors in order to acquire the features and services it wants in a surveillance system; and

WHEREAS, the Avrio Group has submitted a proposal for a wireless system that is all-inclusive, portable, expandable, and may be viewed and controlled by anyone authorized by the City on its network; and

WHEREAS, the Avrio system has been presented to the City Council, as well as to staff in the Police and Public Works Departments, administration, and information technology and has been judged by all to have all the features the City desires. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to negotiate the purchase, installation, and maintenance services for a four-camera wireless surveillance camera system at Roosevelt Center from Avrio Group Surveillance Solutions, Inc., of Easton, Maryland, at a cost of \$39,518 as offered in their revised quotation of May 25, 2007.
