RESOLUTION NUMBER 982

A RESOLUTION TO REPEAL RESOLUTION NUMBER 973 AND ESTABLISH SERVICE CHARGES FOR GARBAGE, TRASH, AND RECYCLING COLLECTIONS IN THE CITY OF GREENBELT, MARYLAND, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2005

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that effective July 1, 2005, Resolution Number 973 shall be repealed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that effective July 1, 2005, the service fee for the collection by the City of Greenbelt of all garbage, trash and recyclable materials from individual housing units shall be \$47.00 per quarter (\$188.00 per annum); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that residents may choose to have a regular second weekly refuse pickup at an additional cost of \$28 per quarter (\$112.00 per annum); residents may also receive a one-time second pickup at a cost of \$15 per pickup; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the annual fee for residents who receive refuse collection from another provider, but wish to receive city recycling pick-up, shall be \$25 per annum; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all trash and garbage collected from commercial establishments shall be on a contractual basis, at a monthly fee sufficient to meet all costs of collection incurred by the city, as determined by the City Manager; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the city shall be responsible for the collection of recyclable materials such as glass, metal, aluminum, newspaper, cardboard, mixed paper and other materials as deemed by the City Manager from its refuse customers and any other locations within the boundaries of Greenbelt as agreed to by the City Manager; and

PASSED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland at its regular meeting of June 20, 2005.
