A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE MUNICIPAL LIVABLE COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE
GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, Prince George's County Executive Jack B. Johnson has established a Livable Communities Initiative (LCI) that includes a \$1 million grant program for municipalities; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting of November 28, 2005, the Greenbelt City Council authorized the City Manager to submit an LCI grant application for the funding of four projects; and

WHEREAS, the projects are: 1) acquisition of a street sweeper in cooperation with Berwyn Heights, College Park and New Carrollton; 2) continuation of the Strengthening Families family training program in Springhill Lake; 3) continuation of the volunteer coordinator position; and 4) acquisition and installation of two emergency call boxes; and

WHEREAS, the county is now requiring a properly executed resolution of the municipal legislative body in support of this LCI grant application. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the Municipal Livable Communities Initiative grant application dated December 9, 2005, is approved and fully supported by the City Council.
