RESOLUTION NUMBER 970

A RESOLUTION FOR THE NEGOTIATED PURCHASE OF KENNELS FOR USE IN THE GREENBELT ANIMAL CONTROL FACILITY

WHEREAS, the operation of the City's animal control program requires that animals be secure and impounded until they can be reunited with their owners, appropriate adoptions can be arranged, or the animals can be relocated to appropriate wildlife sanctuaries; and

WHEREAS, a modular structure was approved by City Council Resolution Number 968 to serve as a suitable facility to provide for the safe and temporary housing of live animals; and

WHEREAS, kennel equipment must be purchased and installed separately; and

WHEREAS, cost estimates for kennels were solicited from six manufacturers; and

WHEREAS, the Mason Company, of Leesburg, Ohio, has submitted a quotation to manufacture six kennels that include molded composite UltraBase for interior installation to the job site for a price of \$11,797.20; and

WHEREAS, the Mason Company's quoted price is not only the lowest submitted but is also the only one to include a raised base and drain system. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the City Manager be authorized to contract with the Mason Company, of Leesburg, Ohio, for the purchase of six Animal Control Facility Kennels, as detailed in a Sales Quotation dated February 27, 2004, for a total cost of \$11,797.20, which includes \$10,486.80 for the kennel system and \$1,310.40 for the wall-mounted, swing-up rest benches.
