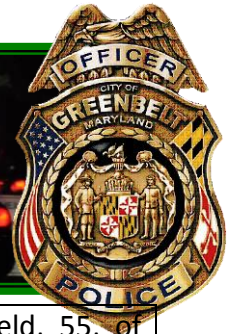
05/30	6100 block Springhill Terrace. Burglary. Unknown person(s) used unknown means to enter the residence and vandalize the interior.

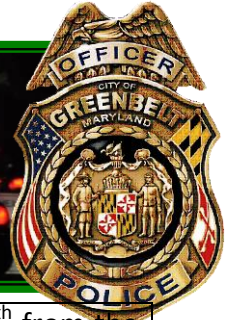
