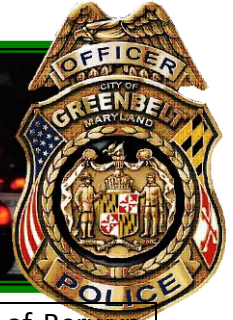

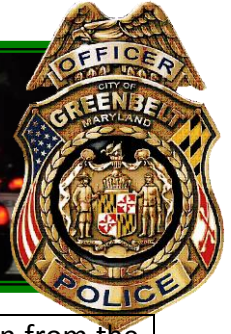

The suspect vehicle is described as a dark colored vehicle, no further.
