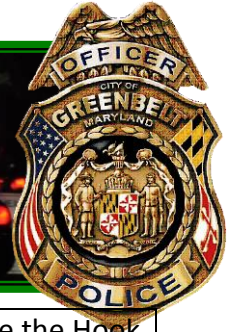

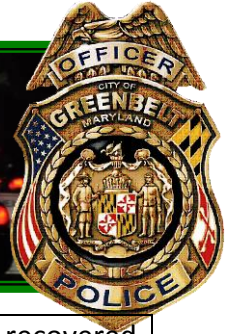
Automotive Crime - City Wide
