Free Powerful Tools for Caregivers Workshop

This six-part educational series of the evidenced based curriculum will help caregivers create a tool box of skills to enable them to care for themselves while caring for someone else living with dementia. The overall goal of the workshop is to empower participants to learn how to take care of their own health and well-being in an effort to become a better caregiver. Class participants are also given The Caregiver Helpbook to accompany the sessions. It is designed to provide them with the tools to increase their selfcare and confidence to handle difficult situations, emotions, and decisions. The Caregiver Helpbook will not eliminate the challenges of caregiving. Powerful Tools for Caregivers has been shown to minimize the negative impact that caregiving has on their lives and help them seek and find resources. The goal is to help caregivers to thrive as individuals while continue to care for their care recipient living in the community.

- Information Needed with Application
- Copy of Applicant's photo identification
- Proof of Residency
- Copies of Social Security cards for the entire household (including children)
- Proof of your household's total Gross income for the last 30 day period
- A copy of your most recent Utility bill, termination notice (if applicable)
- A copy of your most recent heating fuel bill or receipt (if applicable)

Renters Tax Credit 2021

The State of Maryland provides a direct check payment of up to \$1,000.00 a year for renters who paid rent in the State of Maryland and who meet certain eligibility requirements. Registration opened February 1, 2021 and the deadline for filing an application is October 1, 2021. A properly completed application means that all questions are answered, the form is signed, copies of the entire federal income tax return, schedules and forms, necessary Social Security form (SSA1099), Railroad Retirement Verification or rate letter are all included and applicant has provided responses to any subsequent inquiries made by the Department in a reasonable timeframe.
