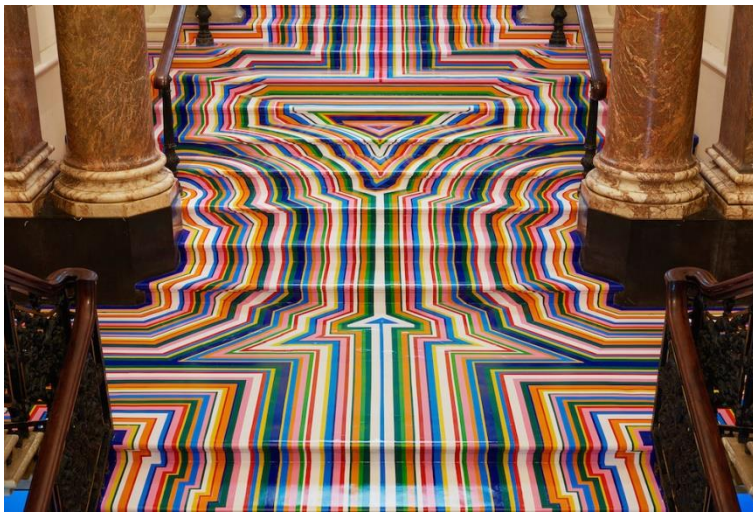


Abstraction Action

Here are two artists who create bright, colorful works using repeating forms or “shape families”. Enjoy these images as added inspiration for the Abstraction Action activity provided by Australia’s National Gallery of Victoria.

Artist Jim Lambie, from Scotland, also creates large works in spaces that you can move through. You may have seen his piece *Zobop* at the [Hirshhorn Museum](#)!

Notice how the lines seem to reflect like ripples of water off the objects and surfaces they touch. You can create this effect in a drawing! Place some shapes on your page, then outline them in multiple colors.
