Park and Recreation Advisory Board Report to City Council

SUBJECT: PRAB Composition and Size

BACKGROUND: At its regular monthly meeting on April 16, the Park and Recreation Advisory Board again discussed the possibility of a smaller Board. Members were in favor of a smaller Board since it is difficult to recruit. However, Kelly Ivy reported that a resident is very interested in applying and only recently has found the time in her schedule to serve if appointed. The general consensus was that a larger Board was more diverse and provided more opportunities for participation by interested residents.

RECOMMENDATIONS: PRAB recommends City Council approval to make the Board size 10 members.
