Buddy Attick Lake Mile Marker Signage

As previously discussed, the final stage to the Buddy Attick Lake Mile Marker Project is to design and install explanatory signage. We have attempted to make the signs clear, concise, universal and have provided both English and Spanish versions.

The signage will consist of signage at the main parking lot as well as signage at the other three entrances to the lake path (Greenhill Rd entrance, Lakeside Rd entrance, Braden Field / tennis court entrance).

The signage at the main entrance will consist of larger signs (one in English and one in Spanish) of 20 inches by 20 inches each. The signage at the other three entrances will be smaller at 12 inches by 12 inches and again there will be both English and Spanish versions of the signs at each location.


Sign construction will be painted metal, reflective and will be white with black lettering. The universal icons representing "police", "fire" and "EMS" will in color. The signs will be similar to typical roadway signage.

We have included paper draft versions of each size of the signs and both the English and Spanish versions for review.


