

**Greenbelt Youth Advisory Committee
Report to City Council**

Subject: Ideas on how Youth Advisory Committee might become a more active group.

Discussion: YAC reviewed the request on how it might become a more active group at its monthly meeting on October 9. Those present questioned whether YAC needed to be more active when the City has been receptive to their prior program and facility concerns.

YAC plans on remaining an active civic organization by:

- a) Continuing to provide the Recreation Department feedback regarding their programs and class offerings to youth.
- b) Providing additional recommendations to City Council on city issues involving youth.
- c) Providing feedback regarding the condition of city athletic fields and facilities.
- d) Recruitment & Retention
Identify YAC members who have moved as a result of school and assess their ability to serve on the committee.
Develop a search subcommittee to increase meeting attendance and provide information for local youth who may be interested in volunteering.

Recommendation: YAC plans to implement the aforementioned steps to remain active.
