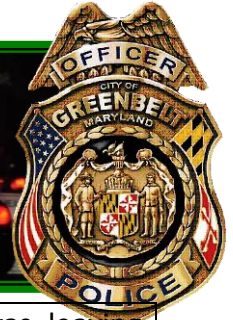
11/12	6002 Springhill Drive. Theft. A wristwatch was taken from a residence.

The victim advised that he was leaving Beltway Plaza when he was approached by the two suspects, with one suspect demanding money from the victim then punching and kicking him. After taking money from the victim both suspects fled the area on foot. The suspects are described as a black male in his early twenties, 5'7" with a thin build, wearing a yellow and blue shirt and a black male in his early twenties, 5'7" with a thin build, wearing a dark green shirt.

Officers located an adult male victim suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to a local hospital for treatment where he was later pronounced deceased. There is no suspect information at this time. The victim was later identified as 30 year old Yordano Fabian Vargus of Greenbelt. The investigation is ongoing.

11/17 4:06 P.M.	7501 Greenway Center Drive. Theft. An unattended wallet was taken from an office suite.

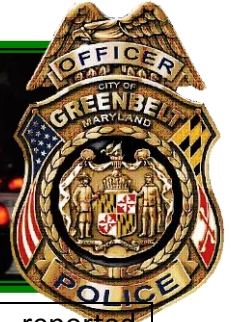
