## City Manager's Report Week Ending December 18, 2020

- 1. Attached are the June, July and August monthly statistical reports from the Police Department.
- 2. Met with the City's financial consultants Davenport & Associates to discuss next steps in Council discussion regarding a comprehensive financial review. The work could start as early as January 2021 with the intent to support discussion on capital projects during the Spring 2021 Council budget work sessions. Treasurer Bertha Gaymon is reviewing materials from Spring 2020 and updated information. The City would use the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG) rider in the City of Falls Church's agreement.
- 3. Reviewing GILA outreach material at the request of GILA. The City greatly appreciates the fundraising and services that faith and spiritual groups are doing to help our neighbors in need. Donations can be made directly on the City website to support their efforts.
- 4. The Community Foundation has awarded \$10,000 to support utility relief via GILA. The City will serve as fiscal agent.
- 5. Approved a rental housing relief grant via GILA's fund.
- 6. Approved the hiring of a police officer.
- 7. Continued to work with the Recreation Department on monitoring the status of the Aquatic & Fitness Center.
- 8. Providing Councilmember Turner's office with referrals to organizations supporting families in need related to holiday gifts.
- 9. Participating in Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments' (MWCOG) regional equity town hall series along with other staff. As noted at the MWCOG annual meeting, recorded past sessions are available for MWCOG members to access.
- 10. Listened in on the MWCOG regional snow emergency call. While we were not set for a large amount of snow as in other parts of the region, the new WebEx format is a great improvement allowing one to see the National Weather Service material during the presentation (versus just listening on the phone).
- 11. Met with and/or teleconferenced with staff, City Solicitor, and outside counsel on personnel and legal matters.
- 12. Reviewed draft meeting minutes.
- 13. Participated in the Council Regular Meeting and the Council Work Session with Franklin Park Apartments (Fieldstone Company).
