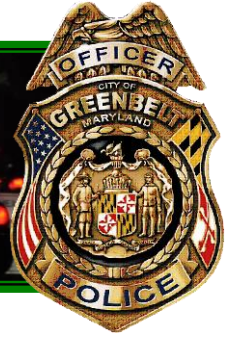

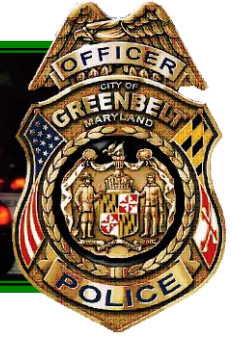

The victim advised that he was putting air in his tires at the BP Service Station when he was approached by the suspect, who produced an unknown type long gun and demanded the victim's car keys. The suspect then fled the scene in the victim's 2016 Dodge Charger. The vehicle was recovered later the same evening by the United States Park Police in the area of Minnesota Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue S.E., Washington, D.C. One adult arrest was made.
