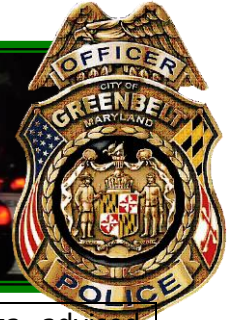

The victim, a security officer for Beltway Plaza, advised that he was patrolling the rear parking lot of the mall when he was approached by a panhandler. When he rolled down the window to speak with him, a second subject walked up and spit on him. The victim then exited his vehicle and a physical confrontation ensued. The suspect then produced a sharp object and cut the victim on the head and face. The suspect then fled the area on foot. The victim was transported to a local hospital for treatment of head lacerations. The suspect is described as a black male, 5'10", 200 pounds, with short bushy hair, wearing a grey jacket, blue jeans and a beanie type hat.
01/11 9:57 P.M.	9100 Springhill Lane. Strong arm robbery. The victim, a food delivery person, advised that he was attempting to deliver an order when he got no response at the door. He was then approached by five suspects, who assaulted him and took cash, his cell phone and the food order. The suspects then fled the area on foot. The victim refused treatment for minor injuries. The suspects are described as five black males, no further.

01/10	7821 Mandan Road. Theft. A parcel package was taken from lobby area of a condominium building.

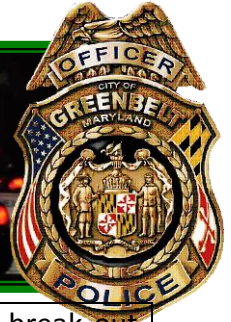
