After meeting the suspect, they were unable to complete the sale by way of a cash phone app. The suspect then implied that he had a handgun then fled the scene with the handbags. The suspect was located at the Greenbelt Metro Station and was positively identified by the victim. The property was also recovered. The youth was released to a parent pending action by the Juvenile Justice System.
