#### **Recognition Groups:**

# • Greenbelt Senior Softball (GSS)-George Harrison

- o GSS is comprised of women over the age of 50, and men over the age of 60.
- o City of Greenbelt residents make up 10% of participation in GSS.
- o The GSS season consists of approximately 44 games.
- o Games are played on fields in six counties.
- o GSS did not have a season last spring due to Covid-19.
- PRAB encouraged Mr. Harrison to include the narrative portion of the application. Items that should to be addressed are low resident participation, recruitment methods and Covid-19 protocol as play resumes.
