- I. The meeting was called to order at 7:45 PM.

- II. Agenda approved as presented
- III. Minutes of February 17, 2021 approved as presented
- IV. NASA Goddard Greenbelt Campus Draft Master Plan and Transportation Management Plan

Staff presented an overview of the NASA Goddard Greenbelt Campus Draft Master Plan and Transportation Management Plan noting areas of question and concern that have been raised by staff. These include lack of detail provided about the National Register-eligible historic district and a lack of discussion about electric vehicles. Staff also provided a brief overview of the City's previous involvement, including the review of the Draft Environmental Assessment which was discussed by City Council and a letter was submitted noting areas of concern.

The Board then discussed areas of concern about the plan including that a concern that the plan was not forward thinking enough. Mr. Lippert noted that this plan should include zero energy buildings and autonomous vehicles. It was also noted that the 12-shuttle passenger bus should be electric. Ms. Gournay asked about criteria for historic preservation that were not detailed in the plan and asked about public outreach in terms of the changes that are proposed within the plan. The Board also discussed access to the campus for active transportation options. Specifically noting that Greenbelt residents, high school, and college students need to be able to access the campus safely. The Board also wanted information about the plants that are proposed within the plan. At the conclusion of the discussion the Board agreed to draft a report that echoed staff's comments with additional concerns raised by the Board. The Board also agreed to continue this discussion at the next meeting.

- V. No new business was discussed.
1. Update on Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment Discussions

Mr. Friedman provided an update on the discussions that are being held about increasing Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment in Greenbelt. He noted that the group has discussed how to make recommendations to Council and potential developers and further stated that information had been sent to the City regarding these recommendations. Staff noted that the survey created by the group has been posted on the website, but had no further update. Mr. Friedman and Mr. Lippert invited all members of APB to participate in these discussions.
