DO YOU WANT TO RUN FOR CITY COUNCIL?

Any qualified voter who is at least 18 years of age may be nominated for City Council!

Monday, August 16th is the first day to obtain papers and file a nomination petition.

Monday, September 27th by 5:00 p.m. is the last day to file a nomination petition.

You will need to file a nomination petition with the City Clerk's office. This petition must be signed by 50 or more registered voters who reside in the City of Greenbelt. You will also need a written accepance of the nomination.

Once the nomination petition, the written acceptance, and any other statements that may be required are submitted to the City Clerk, the name of such nominee will be authorized to be placed upon the ballot.

Remove Mosquito Habitats

The City of Greenbelt has seen an increase in its mosquito population. It is crucial for residents to help stop the spread of mosquito-borne diseases. Mosquitoes need water for two stages of their life cycle, it's important to monitor standing water sources.



- Every time it rains get rid of standing water in old tires, buckets, plastic covers, toys or any other container where mosquitoes can breed.
- During the wet months check at least once a week check rain gutters and potted plant trays.
- Periodically change the water in bird baths, fountains, and wading pools.
- Drain temporary pools of water or fill with dirt.
- Keep swimming pool water treated and circulating.
