
Fun for All Ages

Kinder Camp

Ages: 3.5 to 5

Pre-kindergarten children will spend camp days participating in craft projects, story times, games, and will spend much of their time exploring and moving outside. Each session has a special theme, and campers can look forward to engaging activities hosted by special guests. We are looking forward to another wonderful Summer!



Camp Pine Tree

Ages 6 to 8 & 9 to 11

Explore opportunities in sports, crafts, field games, and a variety of unique, age-appropriate challenges and experiences. Campers receive instructional swim four times, free swim twice, and take part in special all-camp events.



Creative Kids Camp

Ages 6 to 12

Campers explore the arts and develop their talents, while making new friends and having fun in a caring environment that affirms every child. Our camp shows this year is Summer Circus, about a group of cousins who help their eccentric Aunt Beverly present a circus extravaganza.



Camp YOGO

Ages 12 to 15

Customize Your Camp Day

Both half-day and full-day options are available this year, along with Before Care and After Care for an extended day. See Pages 12 and 13 for program descriptions.

Creative Kids Camp is our popular rotation of music, dance, visual art, and drama/circus activities culminating in the performance of the Creative Kids Camp musical! Full-day campers will stay on after lunch to participate in the Afternoon Art Adventure you have chosen for the camp session.

Campers explore the arts and develop their talents, while making new friends and having fun in a caring environment that affirms every child.



Our camp musical is **Summer Circus**, which tells the story of a group of cousins who are invited to spend the summer on the farm with their eccentric Aunt Beverly, only to discover that she is trying to rescue a failing circus! Naturally, the kids pitch in to help. They have the best summer ever, and so will you!

Program Elements

Before Care:

A relaxed, friendly start to the day with supervised indoor play. Campers are also welcome to enjoy some quality time with a good book! Complimentary light breakfast is provided.

Morning Mix:

Campers will enjoy our popular, lively rotation of short classes in music, dance, visual art, and drama/circus, with occasional visits from the Greenbelt Park Rangers and activities with the Greenbelt Museum. Families who are opting for a half-day camp will enroll in Morning Mix and pick up their camper at lunchtime.

On the final Friday of each session, campers will perform in the 2022 camp musical, Summer Circus. The shows will take place at 10:00 am and 2:15 pm on the final Friday of each camp session. Half-day campers are all invited to stay and perform in the afternoon show, followed by a reception with our Afternoon Art Adventure participants.



Afternoon Art Adventures:

After lunch, full-day campers will settle in for an in-depth creative exploration. Each camper will participate in a single class per session. Registration priority is given to campers who are enrolled in the Morning Mix.

After Care:

Campers enjoy a variety of lightly structured activities, including supervised play and open art studio. On Tuesdays and Thursdays, campers have the option of supervised free swim at the Greenbelt Aquatic and Fitness Center's outdoor pool. Campers may also attend occasional films at the Old Greenbelt Theatre, the city's historic cinema in nearby Roosevelt Center. Complimentary snack is provided.


Notes Before Registering for Camp Encore

Before and After Care

These extended-day offerings are available for all camps. During Before Care and After Care, lightly structured activities and free play areas are supervised by camp staff. Greenbelt Recreation supports proper nutrition for extended-day campers by offering breakfast and snacks at no extra charge:

- Breakfast is served during **Before Care**, up to 8:15 am. Campers can choose one of three nutritious breakfast options: (1) a bowl of Cheerios, (2) a slice of whole-grain toast with peanut butter, or (3) a bowl of instant oatmeal, each with milk and juice or fresh fruit.
- A nutritious snack is provided to all campers during **After Care**.

Starting on page 20 of this brochure you will find all of our registration forms. Registration forms must be complete to process your registration and to reserve your spot in camp. Priority goes to those who register first, so register today!

2 SUBMIT COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORMS

COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORMS should be submitted via email. All camp contact information is provided below. Forms will be accepted from Greenbelt residents* for Summer Camps **beginning on Monday, April 11 at 10:00 am and from non-residents beginning on Monday, April 18 at 10:00 am. Registrations received before the start date/time will not be accepted.** Please submit proof of Greenbelt residency to receive the resident rate. If registration via email is not possible, please contact the designated staff member. Camper registration forms will be accepted on an ongoing basis until all slots are filled. At that point, interested persons' names will be placed on a waiting list. Those persons will be contacted in the order in which names were taken if/when a slot becomes available.
