RESOLUTION NUMBER 2094

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT, MARYLAND
PROVIDING FOR A REFERENDUM TO BE HELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO
THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT, MARYLAND, THE QUESTION OF WHETHER
TO ESTABLISH A GREENBELT COMMISSION TO STUDY AND DEVELOP LOCAL
REPARATIONS PROPOSALS

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to submit to the voters of the City of Greenbelt the question of whether to establish a Greenbelt commission to study and develop local reparations proposals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT THAT:

The City Council of the City of Greenbelt:

1. Places a Referendum Question on the ballot of the 2021 City Election related to reparations.
2. The Referendum language for this question shall be as follows:

Do you vote yes or no to the following Referendum question:

The City Council of Greenbelt should establish a twenty-one (21) member Commission to review, discuss, and make recommendations related to local reparations for African American and Native American residents of Greenbelt.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, at its regular meeting of August 9, 2021.
