

The Business Telework Assistance Grant Program assists businesses with retaining and creating jobs across the State. Funded with **\$1 million** in the Office of Telework Assistance within the Department of Commerce, the program will provide grants of up to **\$25,000** to help businesses expand telework capabilities for their employees.

These grants will help applicants purchase the equipment necessary to develop and implement telework policies, including hardware, software, and technical services.

Round 1 applications are due by **Friday, January 6.**
