# Reminder: Invitation to Council Work Session "Bring Your Own Bag" Ordinance



#### Wednesday, March 8, 2023, at 7:30 pm City Council Chambers – 25 Crescent Road

The Greenbelt City Council is considering a Bring Your Own Bag Ordinance and wants input from the merchants:

This ordinance bans single-use plastic film carryout bags and requires retailers to charge at least 10-15 cents for paper carryout bags. The charge for paper bags reduces the demand for them and is an incentive to bring your own bag. The charge for paper bags helps the merchants to not incur that cost.

This ordinance covers all Greenbelt establishments selling goods in Greenbelt, including grocery stores, restaurants, department stores, and small businesses.
