This grant supports business recovery efforts related to business interruption, improvements and continuity. Applicants must meet eligibility guidelines and provide evidence of financial impact due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Award Amounts:

Maximum award amount is \$50,000.

Minimum Award Amount is \$40,000.

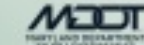
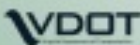
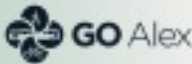
