ORDINANCE NUMBER 1255

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2005, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000) FOR ADDITIONAL PROJECT EXPENDITURES OVER THE APPROPRIATED AMOUNT

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant Fund for fiscal year 2005 was approved at \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the estimated expenses of street resurfacing projects are \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the City was allowed to reprogram unspent grant monies remaining from previous program years; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and City Treasurer have certified that revenues are available for the purpose of making this appropriation in the amount of \$150,000. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that the following amount shall be and hereby is appropriated as a supplemental appropriation for expenditures herein shown for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005, in the Community Development Block Grant Fund:

For the additional cost of resurfacing streets in the City

Said supplemental appropriation is in addition to the appropriation of \$100,000 made by Ordinance No. 1245 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, thereby making the total appropriation in the Community Development Block Grant Fund for the fiscal year in the amount of \$250,000.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
