ORDINANCE NUMBER 1257

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION IN THE SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2005, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$29,000) FOR EXPENDITURES OVER THE APPROPRIATED AMOUNT

WHEREAS, the Special Projects Fund for fiscal year 2005 was approved at \$81,000; and

WHEREAS, the estimated expenditures of the Special Projects Fund are \$110,000; and

WHEREAS, the city received two unanticipated public safety grants totaling \$39,000, which caused the increased expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and City Treasurer have certified that the Special Projects Fund revenues and fund balance are available for the purpose of making this appropriation in the amount of \$29,000; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Greenbelt, Maryland, that an additional \$29,000 shall be and hereby is appropriated as a supplemental appropriation for expenditures herein shown for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004, and ending June 30, 2005, in the Special Projects Fund. Said supplemental appropriation is an addition to the appropriation of \$81,000 made by Ordinance No. 1245 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, thereby making the total appropriation in the Special Project Fund for the fiscal year in the amount of \$110,000.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
