Museum Weekly Report For Week Ending July 28, 2023

Museum Activities

Programs:

- Planning for Labor Day is ongoing. The Retro Town Fair entry form has been updated and promotion has begun.
- Researching speakers for FY 2024 lecture series. Corresponded with professor from Emory University whose focus area is public housing in the 1930s in Atlanta. Invited her to speak in October, awaiting her answer.
- Staff has begun discussing programs or activities in honor of Hispanic Heritage Month in October.
- Reparations Commission: Next meeting will take place August 16. Subcommittees are meeting in the meantime. Director will give a tour of the Museum house in August for those interested. Ongoing monitoring of emails and answering questions from commissioners.
- Archives: Responded to two unrelated inquiries from scholars researching *The City*, the
 documentary that features Greenbelt shown at the 1939 NY World's Fair. One is a
 professor in the School of Architecture at University of Southern California in Los
 Angeles. The other is a faculty member who teaches video and documentary filmmaking
 in the school of Media, Film, and Journalism in the Faculty of Arts at Monash University,
 Melbourne Australia. The latter will be in Greenbelt on Monday, July 31 to meet with
 staff and have a tour of the Museum house.
- Museum house: Opened the Museum again on Sunday July 23 for tours to resume 100% of pre-pandemic operations. 9 people visited. In an ongoing effort to make sure guests have the best experience, we are continuing to offer tours on the ½ hour beginning at 1pm. Laminated signs were posted at both 10A and 10B to direct visitors. Staff is discussing acquiring a sandwich board to set up in the driveway on Sundays. House will be open again on July 28 from 1-5pm.
- Recreation Department: As of July 1, the Museum has moved to the Rec Dept.
 Timesheets, etc. are now submitted via the department. Museum operations should remain largely unchanged. Will meet with Rec Dept leadership in September to discuss moving to further discuss operations and administration.
- Museum Collection: Museum was offered an FDR button from one of his presidential campaigns by a Greenbelt resident, will accept into the Museum Collection.
