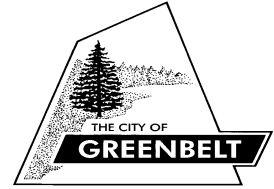

*The following items highlight the various activities of the staff of Planning and Community Development for the past week.*

#### CODE ENFORCEMENT

Alarms:	Twenty-four alarm renewal notices were mailed to businesses; and One alarm renewal notice was mailed to an alarm company.
Complaints:	Ten complaints were logged regarding inoperable windows and lights, drywall and siding in disrepair, defective walking surface, broken mail boxes, unsecured front doors, roach infestation, possible mold/odor, and a leak in a bathroom; Four complaints were re-inspected; and Three unlicensed rental letters were sent.
Construction Sediment Erosion Control:	Charles P. Johnson and Associates conducted inspections of the stormwater pond project on Hanover Parkway; and Worked with Charles P. Johnson on finalizing release of Motiva's Erosion and Sediment Control bonds to maintenance bond status.
Permits:	Three permits were approved and issued.
Rentals:	Five rentals were inspected; and One rental was re-inspected.
Windshield Inspections:	Belle Point Drive, Greenhill Road, Hillside Road, Lakecrest Circle, Maplewood Court, Morrison Drive, Southway, and Vanity Fair Drive were observed for tall grass/overgrown weeds, trash/debris, trash cans in public view, a damaged storm water catch basin, a broken water main, and improper yard waste disposal; and Greenbelt Road was observed for possible illegal signs.

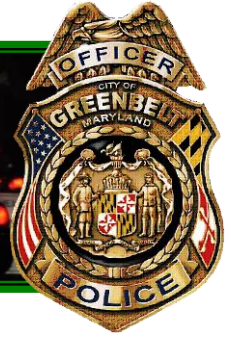
