Ride-Along Information Greenbelt City Police Department

Application for Ride-Along Participants – keep this sheet for your records!

Complete the application and be sure to give three optional dates and the time of day which would be convenient for you to ride along. An officer's shift is 8.5 hours long. You may ride for an entire shift or you may depart anytime during those 8.5 hours.

Processing your application can take from two days to seven days. Please contact the Office of the Chief of Police at 301/507-6500 to verify approval and the date and time of your ride-along.

It is the policy of this Department that each participant be limited to one time only. Ride-along hours are 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. inclusive.

Guidelines for Ride-Along Participants

In order to facilitate this program, the following guidelines have been established. You are requested to:

Be appropriately attired in such a manner that will in no way reflect negatively upon you, the program or the Department. The following are examples of types of clothing which are not acceptable:

- 1. shorts, ripped/torn jeans or sweatpants
- 2. flip-flops
- 3. sweat shirts, t-shirts or tank tops

Arrange for transportation to and from police headquarters. You are encouraged to ask questions about police work. However, bear in mind your police partner cannot conceivably know about every even that has occurred.

In order to comply with Department Policies and Procedures, you <u>MUST</u> utilize the safety belts and other safety equipment at all times. Certain police calls are considered inherently dangerous and your police partner may respond to the call after dropping you off at a safe place. Wait for a pick-up police vehicle at the specific location at which you are dropped off if this becomes necessary.

DO NOT interfere in any way with the officer's handling of a situation; you may ask questions concerning a specific assignment after it has been completed and you have left the scene.

You may observe an event on your ride which could require your appearance in court as a witness.

A waiver of liability form (<u>General Release</u>) is attached and is required to be executed by yourself and <u>notarized prior to a ride-along</u>. In essence, it released Greenbelt City from liability for any injury or other disability you might sustain during the ride.
