MINUTES OF THE FOREST PRESERVE ADVISORY BOARD MEETING HELD THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2013 IN THE GREENBELT COMMUNITY CENTER

CALL TO ORDER: Chair Ruth Kastner called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: The agenda was approved without change.

HAMILTON PLACE CLEARING: The agenda item was a follow-up to the December, 2012 meeting about clearing that had occurred around the Hamilton Place gardens. The following points/concerns/questions were discussed:

- The circumstances and events surrounding the clearing of vegetation from around the Hamilton Place gardens, which occurred without proper review and authorization.
- Actions taken since the clearing took place.
- Questioned if archeological resources were damaged during the clearing.
- Actions being taken which would suppress revegetation of the cleared areas.
- Internal accountability and what internal city processes were in place to guard against future similar incidents.
- Suggested consultation with MNCPPC staff studying the Hamilton family cemetery.
- Concern re. consultation with the garden club which may have contributed to decisions to clear around the gardens.
- How the routine garden maintenance would continue in the aftermath of the mistaken clearing

It was moved and seconded that the FPAB prepare a report about the clearing and recommendations for new procedures to ensure similar events do not occur. The motion was approved by a vote of 8-0.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no more business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:27 p.m.
