In regard to the recent reports of credit card fraud, the COOP Supermarket is continuing to work with IT security professionals to determine the cause and to rectify the situation.

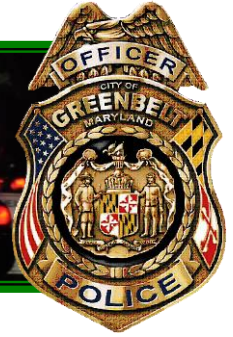

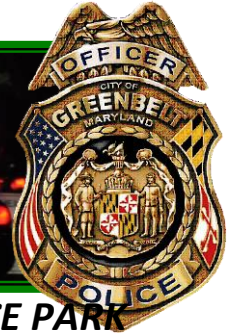

The suspects then took money from the registers and removed the automatic teller machine from the premises. The suspects then fled the scene in the vehicle. The suspects are described as two black males, with black hair and brown eyes and no description given for the third suspect. |

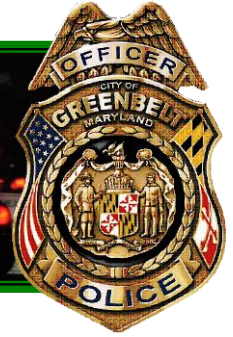

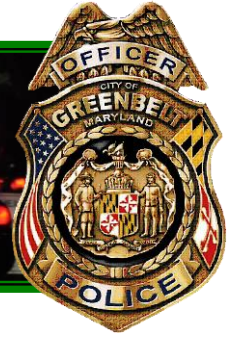

While driving through the area of Greenbelt Road and Hanover Parkway the driver asked the victim if he was 'scared'. The driver then produced a handgun and ordered the victim out of the cab. The suspect then fled the scene in the cab. The suspect is described as an Indian male, 40 to 50 years of age, 5'6" to 5'8", 150 to 180 pounds. The vehicle is described as a navy blue Ford Crown Victoria 4-door, with the word 'airport' on the side. |
