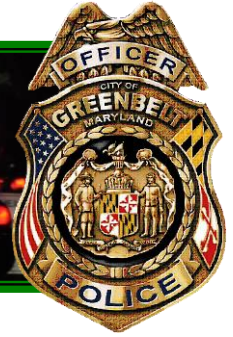

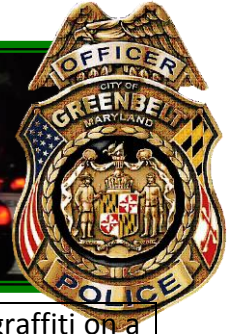
CENTER CITY

07/20 5:40 P.M.	7500 block Greenbelt Road. Theft. An unattended cell phone was taken from the Subway Restaurant.

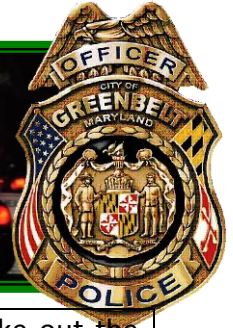
