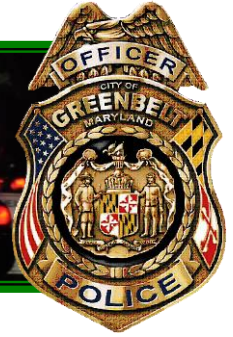
### Residential Burglary in the 5900 block of Cherrywood Terrace

On September 30<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 5:40 A.M., the victim was asleep in bed when she heard two unknown subjects speaking about removing the victim's clothing. The victim then observed one of the suspects in her bedroom. The victim grabbed her cell phone and ran from the apartment. The suspects also fled the scene. It was later discovered that a cell phone and a white Schwinn Solara mountain bike were taken from the residence. The first suspect is described as a black male, 6', 160 pounds, with short black hair, wearing blue jeans, blue under shorts showing above the jeans and no shirt. The victim did not see the second suspect. Entry was probably gained by way of an unsecured sliding glass door.
