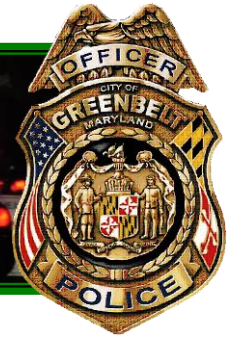

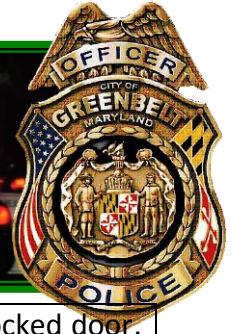

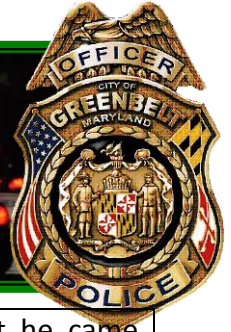
GREENBELT EAST/GREENWAY SHOPPING CENTER
