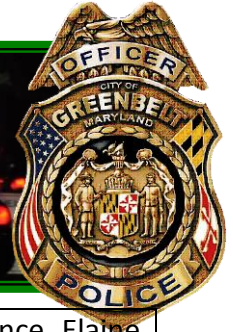

A witness advised that he heard noises coming from inside the garage area then heard the alarm sound. He then observed the suspect exit the building, run to a nearby vehicle and flee the scene. Nothing appears to have been taken. The suspect is described as a male, 6', with a thin build, wearing a grey hooded sweatshirt and jeans. The vehicle is described as a dark colored Honda, no further.

Tiffany Owens, 37, of Laurel, MD was arrested and charged with Driving While Impaired by Alcohol and other traffic-related charges as a result of being stopped for a traffic violation. The victim advised that on May 6 th at approximately 7:00 P.M. he was approached by the three suspects, one who threatened the victim then demanded cash. After getting cash from the victim the suspects told the victim to go to the COOP Supermarket and withdraw money from the ATM. The victim complied, then walked back outside and gave the money to the suspects. The victim then ran from the area. It is unknown why the victim waited to report the incident. The suspects are described as a black male, 5'4", 160 pounds, wearing a green hooded sweatshirt, a black male, 5'9", 145 pounds, wearing a red hooded sweatshirt and a black male, no further.

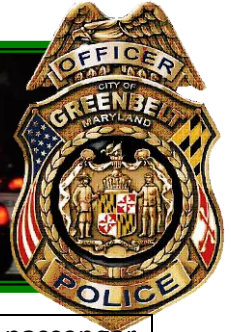
