


### **GREENBELT EAST/GREENWAY SHOPPING CENTER**

01/12 2:20 P.M.	6900 block Hanover Parkway. Burglary. The victim advised that entry was gained by forcing open the front door. The victim believes that the incident is domestic-related and the investigation is ongoing.
01/15 12:50 A.M.	7200 block Hanover Drive. Cutting. The victim advised that he was stabbed by another subject at the front entrance of Willy K's Bar and Restaurant during a verbal altercation. The suspect is described as a black male 5'8" to 6'3", with a medium build, wearing a black knit cap and all black clothing. The suspect fled the scene on foot in the company of a second subject described as a black male 6' to 6'4", with black hair in long dreadlocks, wearing all black clothing. The victim was transported Prince George's General Hospital for treatment.

01/15 9:30 P.M.	7500 block Greenbelt Road. Theft. Unknown person(s) took unattended power tools from a work area inside the Safeway store.
01/17 3:45 P.M.	7900 block Mandan Road. Robbery arrest. Edward Oluwarotimi Adianlewa, 22, of Greenbelt was arrested and charged with Armed Robbery, First Degree Assault, Second Degree Assault and Theft. The victim advised that he was walking with a friend when he was approached from behind by the suspect, who threatened him with a knife and took his cell phone. The suspect was followed by another witness as he left the area, at which time the suspect threw the victim's cell phone and attempted to flee the scene, still followed by the witness. The suspect was stopped by officers and was positively identified by the victim. The suspect was transported to the Department of Corrections for a hearing before a District Court Commissioner.


## Automotive Crime - City Wide

01/15	7800 block Mandan Road. Vandalism to auto. Unknown person(s) broke out the passenger side window of a vehicle.

At one point the suspect exited his vehicle and threw a water bottle at the victim's car. The victim then exited her vehicle and vandalized the suspect's windshield wiper. The suspect then pulled a windshield wiper off the victim's car and struck the victim's windshield with it, damaging the windshield. The suspect then fled the scene. The suspect is described as a black male in his mid-twenties, 5'7" to 5'10", wearing a green jacket. The suspect vehicle is described as a greenish blue passenger car, no further.
