Maryland State Police Arrest Prince Georges Co. Man For Child Pornography

(Greenbelt, MD) Maryland State Police investigators from the Maryland Internet Crimes Section, Maryland Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force, arrested a Prince George's County man earlier today on child pornography related charges.

The suspect is identified as Rodney White, 50, of the 6900 block of Hanover Parkway, Greenbelt, MD. White was arrested without incident and charged with possession of child pornography, displaying obscene matter to a minor and distributing child pornography.

Earlier this year, investigators with the Maryland Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force developed information about the potential distribution of child pornography over the Internet. As a result of the subsequent investigation, White was identified as the suspect and a search warrant was served at White's residence shortly after 5:00 a.m. this morning, by Maryland State Police Computer Crimes Unit investigators, state troopers from the College Park Barrack, agents from Homeland Security Investigations and officers from the Greenbelt Police Department.

Service of the search warrant resulted in the recovery of various digital media storage devices. Evidence will be submitted to the Maryland State Police Digital Forensics Lab for analysis. Investigators consulted with the Prince George's County State's Attorney's Office regarding charges that were placed. White was transported to the Prince George's County Central Booking for processing and a hearing before a District Court commissioner.

The Maryland Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force is comprised of police agencies from around the state. Its primary mission is to protect children from computer-facilitated sexual exploitation. The Task Force works cooperatively with law enforcement agencies and prosecutors to
