Barricade Situation

On Monday, October 2nd, at approximately 6:58 P.M., officers responded to a report of unknown trouble at a residence in the 7800 block of Hanover Parkway. Investigation revealed that the incident was a domestic assault, with the male suspect assaulting the female victim and threatening her with a knife. The victim was able to flee the residence and contact police, leaving a three year old child inside. The suspect, along with the child and another male adult, remained inside the residence. The suspect refused to come out and the situation was deemed a barricade situation. The Prince George's County Police Department's Emergency Services Team was notified and responded to the scene. The suspect, Mario Alexander Rodriguez, 35, of Greenbelt was apprehended at 11:27 P.M. and taken into custody without incident. The child was located safe in the residence. The other adult male was released without charge. Charges are pending for the Rodriguez suspect.
